Greetings!

As the Executive Director, I would like to take this opportunity to welcome you to X-Tending Hands, Inc. (XTH) and tell you what we have been doing this past year. As you may know, our primary goal is to provide distinct and accessible housing in the Orange, Seminole, Lake and Osceola counties to persons suffering from HIV/AIDS. 2009 was a year marked by the need to innovate and collaborate in order to continue serving individuals infected and or affected by the HIV/AIDS virus in Orlando, FL.

Last year, we served over 50 individuals through the provisions of transitional housing at our two residential housing facilities. We are proud to announce that of these 50, we placed 9 individuals in permanent housing. We continue to meet our goal of transitioning individuals from homelessness to independence, and look forward to sharing many more success stories with you in years to come.

XTH has continued fostering strong relationships with our community-based organizations such as Orange County Health Department, the University of Central Florida's Center for Public and Nonprofit Management, and New Hearts Encouragement Ministries, Inc. We recognize the power of collaboration over completion. The synergy created by these collaborative partnerships enables us to provide the supportive services and quality housing that our clients deserve.

In October 2009, we were able to acquire ownership to the women's home in the Pine Hills community. We are also engaged in extensive grant-writing to fund a new program, called Strengthening Communities, which will provide our current clients and future clients job force readiness. In addition, we have partnered with Unleashing Performance to help us provide cutting-edge Leadership, Program Development, Management Training, and Fundraising Development. This will help us succeed in our newest program, Strengthening Communities in Central Florida Program that will help get our community back to work.

Although our agency has big plans for the future, we are committed, and our staff is here to provide quality services for our clients. We are still seeking to expand our menu of services so that we can eventually offer permanent housing for our clients, allowing them to transition into independent living and live with dignity at an affordable cost.

I am excited to share our annual report with you, and hope that after reading it, you will consider partnering with us to make a difference in the lives of individuals infected with HIV/AIDS in our community.




Financials Overview 2019-2020
